- **Ride the Buckeye Train!** The America 250-OH Buckeye Train will embark on a journey along the historic Panhandle Pennsylvania Railroad line, from Columbus to Dennison on April 25, 2026, followed by a roundtrip excursion from Newark to Coshocton to Dennison on April 26.
- **Visit America's Homefront!** Whether you ride in on the Buckeye Train or travel on your own, this event will celebrate Ohio's transportation and WWII heritage in Dennison, Ohio. Dennison, nicknamed Dreamsville USA for its role in serving 1.3 million soldiers or 13% of all armed personnel during WWII, will come alive with 1940s canteen and WWII reenactments, USO Shows, a 250-vehicle Car Show, transportation displays and food trucks. Visit the Museum, a National Historic Landmark, representing the best example of a WWII Servicemen's Canteen in the country.
- **See the Vintage Plan Fly-over!** During the event, and on the train ride back to Columbus on Saturday, Vintage Aircraft Flyovers will take place. A Vintage Aircraft Show is planned at nearby Harry Clever Field in New Philadelphia, where John Glenn learned to fly.
